Fryerns East Reference Group

Work continues in Fryerns East where the residents in the reference group are taking actions to solve some of the issues in the area. During the last meeting at Frypa Hall other community workers were invited along to meet with the residents. Debbie Hunt who chairs the "Friends of Craylands" group talked to residents about setting up a group in Fryerns East to be able to organise social events and highlighted the importance of having dedicated residents and volunteers to organise any activity in the community. Large scale maps of the entire area were provided to help residents identify the problem areas. Police officers were also present in the meeting and able to answer questions from residents.

An Open Day is planned to take place on the 26 May 07.

The idea was suggested by the residents to work with the young people from the area and hear how they want to spend their spare time instead of getting bored on the streets. As there are funds available to run regular events, the group decided to have an event dedicated to youth only, inviting all the young people from the area to attend. The event will give the young people a chance to tell us exactly what they are interested in and sign up for weekly activities. During the day several fun activities including a Graffiti workshop, DJ / MC workshops, bouncy castle, face painting and other activities will be provided. (please see the cover page for details)

Youth Rewards Programme

This programme is for everyone aged 16 to 25 living in the Fryerns and Craylands area. It is a partnership project between Basildon District Council, Basildon Police, groups in Craylands and Fryerns area and the Community Development Worker at BBWCVS (Basildon Billericay and Wickford Council for Voluntary Service).

We have received funding to run a six months pilot programme. For the pilot we aim to recruit 20 young people from the area to take part. It is totally **FREE** to sign up, first come first serve basis. If there are more than 20 applicants, a waiting list will be created to allow new members to join the programme in case of future vacancies. Young people will receive points for being active in their communities and volunteering during various community events such as Fun Days, half term activities, environmental improvements, tree planting, leaflet drop, etc. For each hour of their time spent helping the community they will receive 60 points which is equivalent to a £5 reward. No cash will be rewarded. Rewards will vary from cinema tickets to trips to London (members will decide what rewards they would like).

The programme started in April 2007 and we are looking forward to receiving your applications. For more information and an application form, please contact Artak on 01277 658086.
