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Case Study

Reason for referral

Long term condition, Social activities, Physical exercise

At the initial interview, Patient issues were:

- Has arthritis, bladder problems, high blood pressure.
- Lost son last year due to suicide.
- Feels anxious and very lonely.
- Cannot walk much due to pain.
- No friends, lives with her brother who's moved from abroad.

Advice given/action taken:

- Discussed seeking therapy, bereavement counselling, patient not very keen but will think about it.
- Discussed activities, patient would like to exercise but is scared of pain. Client recently had an x-ray and her doctor is exploring further. Referred to Sue Hayes Health for bespoke exercise programme that suits patient taking into account condition.
- Discussed joining social/activity clubs as this might help with isolation.

Since then, patient has benefitted from exercises and is seeking bereavement counselling. This has also helped patient to feel more positive. Client recently contacted SP saying "I just want to thank you for your support".
