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CASE STUDY

Long term condition, social activities, mental health.

At the initial interview, patient's issues were:

- Patient has moved from Dorset, is a victim of domestic violence.
- Although a British citizen, patient hasn't got family in England as they migrated to Australia.
- Currently lives with a family friend in Pitsea and gets support.
- Feels anxious and depressed.
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- ciatica
- Can't cope with stress. Is on antidepressants, steroids and strong pain killers.
- Doesn't eat much, can't walk far as is in pain.

Advice given/action taken:

- Discussed seeking therapy, patient has already attended mood classes with Therapy For You, found it raw and painful. Feels that it is not helping for now but may try again in the future.
- Patient would really like to meet new people and be less isolated. Referred patient to Sue Hayes Heath Fitness for group exercise, Nordic walking and other activities.
- Discussed finances, currently getting ESA, discussed applying for PIP. Referral made to DIAL for benefit advice.
- Patient wants to volunteer. Registered client with Volunteer Essex.

Outcomes: Patient attends exercise classes every week, she has been awarded PIP.

Patient is now employed.
