Opportunity for project funding



Local community group Heart of Pitsea are inviting charities, voluntary organisations, CICs/CIOs, statutory bodies and businesses to submit projects for funding.

Following consultation within the community, three key themes were identified: 1. Health, 2. Skills, 3 Community, and project ideas must address at least one of these objectives.

A further requirement is that the project takes place within the designated Heart of Pitsea boundaries to benefit those who

live, work or go to school within the area, although it is appreciated that a project may also impact on neighbouring areas.

Proposals should also provide added value by including some form of contribution to the project – this could be part funding, matched funding, volunteer time, in-kind resources or generated income.

The deadline for submitting a proposal is Friday 13 July.

Help the Homeless

Help The Homeless' main funding remit is the regular allocation of Small Grants (generally up to £5000) for capital costs only to small and medium-sized charities (those with a turnover of under £1m per annum).

All applications must relate to projects that assist individuals in their return to mainstream society, rather than simply offer shelter or other forms of sustenance.

For grant applications, the upcoming deadlines are: 15th June, 15th September, 15th December.

The Wolfson Foundation



The Wolfson Foundation funds new buildings, refurbishments and equipment for a range of organisations delivering excellent care and support. The Foundation has awarded over £35 million to more than 200 different organisations over the last ten years.

The Foundation's funding in this area is focussed on three themes:

- Palliative Care and Hospices
- Older People
- Transitions and Independence
- The size of these grants varies from around £15,000 to £100,000. Larger grants are given to key, strategic projects deemed ambitious and well thought-out, with a clear long-term focus. Charities are encouraged not to apply more than once every five years. Match funding is required for projects over £50,000.
