Ford Britain Trust

Application Deadline: 31 January 2019

Grants are available to not-for-profit organisations and schools for projects that benefit local communities in Great Britain.

The following levels of funding are available:

- Small Grants of up to £250.
 Three application windows: 1 April 30 June; 1 August 31 October; 1 December 28 February.
- Large Grants of between £251 and £3,000. Two deadlines: 31 January and 31 July

Description:

The Ford Britain Trust offers grant funding to not-for-profit organisations, registered charities and schools for projects which benefit the local community and environment, children and young people, mainstream schools and education, special needs education and people with disabilities.

The funding is for projects being undertaken/expenditure being made in Great Britain.

National News

New Charity Minister announced following Tracey Crouch's resignation

Mims Davies, Conservative MP for Eastleigh, has been announced as the new minister for sport and civil society, following Tracey Crouch's resignation last week.

Mims Davies has demonstrated a commitment to the charity sector, being a trustee of a small military charity and having run the London Marathon in aid of the Cardiac Risk in the Young charity. However, concerns have been expressed by the sector over the full portfolio that she has inherited from Crouch, including social enterprise, youth, sport, loneliness, horse racing, gambling and lotteries.



This news comes after the Autumn budget, announced on Monday 29 October, failed to acknowledge the Civil Society Strategy, which was unveiled only this summer.
