

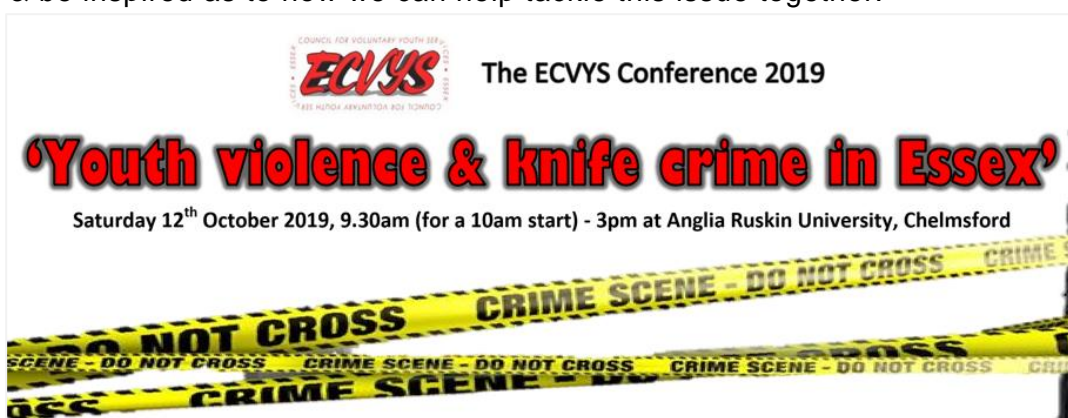

New course aims to help more young BAME women become charity trustees

The Beyond Suffrage programme is free for participants and is being run by the social enterprise Social Practice ENT

This is designed to help more young black, Asian and minority ethnic women to become charity trustees and is a 12-week trustee training scheme for women of colour aged 18 to 25.

Applications for the programme open on 7 October, and will be open to young BAME women who can demonstrate a strong interest in volunteering in the charity sector.



The first cohort of 12 women will be chosen in early December and begin the course in January, with training taking place in London.

Applications close on 9 December at 8am.
